Job Title: Brewer/Cellar person

Roles and responsibilities:

Urban Family Brewing Co. is looking for an experienced brewer to assist with their new 20BBL brewhouse in the Ballard neighborhood in Seattle. This role is responsible for all aspects of beer production, packaging, cleaning, and maintenance. Ideally this person would have 2+ years of commercial brewing experience.

Core duties:

- Wort production as required by the schedule
- Maintain yeast & bacteria cultures, repitching and harvesting as necessary in a sanitary manner
- Monitor fermentation, add dry hops, fruit or other ingredients as needed
- Transfer finished beer, prime as appropriate for bottle conditioning, carbonate as appropriate for force carbonated beers
- Work with the brew staff to ensure the brewery is maintained in a clean and orderly state
- Work with cellar staff and management to schedule brewing, packaging, cleaning and any other tasks.

Training, safety and quality:

- Work with quality team on meeting QA and QC goals, assist with lab work and sensory panels as needed.
- Develop and maintain SOPs and checklists
- Ensure that applicable SOPs are followed and that daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly and annual check lists are completed
- Ensure that cellar staff receive the training they need to complete their jobs in a satisfactory manner
- Report any quality issues to quality team
- Work with quality team to maintain product quality and troubleshoot issues
- Report and troubleshoot health and safety issues as necessary

Maintenance and inventory:

- Help to ensure that adequate levels of supplies are available for all brewery functions
- Maintain all brewery equipment in good working order and ensure that all equipment is correctly calibrated.
- Report any deficiencies or repairs needed to director of operations and coordinate any repairs or replacements needed

Miscellaneous:

- Keep up to date with developments and brewing trends, continuously work on professional development and seek out education whenever possible
- Represent the brewery at functions, festivals and events as needed
- Maintain the brewery's image through professional conduct at all times in dealing with the public, media and other breweries.
